Summer Day Camp

Come join the fun! St. James Episcopal School Summer Day Camp will keep your child entertained with a variety of fun-filled activities and learning experiences. Summer camp at St. James is a special time for children to be creative, build, explore, meet new friends and so much more! Camp will start June 12th and run through July 21st. The week of July 4th will be a shortened 3-day week.

We welcome ages Pre K3 (fully potty trained) through rising 3rd graders. Students that do not attend St. James School may participate in our summer camp program. We will offer a full-day camp from 7:30 – 2:30. Parents may check out our weekly camp schedule and choose which weeks they would like to attend. Camp themes will cover a broad range of interests to satisfy the growing minds of all age groups. Our campers will be taught by passionate and energetic staff who are committed to providing educational and fun opportunities for every child. Please read all information carefully before registering your camper.

We will offer an early registration period for our St. James School families beginning on Monday, February 13th. Registration for non-St. James School students will begin on Monday, March 6th. There is a \$70.00 one-time, non-refundable registration fee for each camper. The registration fee reserves your spot at camp and covers supplies and a camp t-shirt. Extra camp t-shirts may be purchased for \$12.00. You will be financially responsible for registered camp sessions even if your child does not attend. Registration is required for all campers and is not complete until the registration fee is paid and the camp packet is completed. Packets may be picked up at St. James School Office at 860 N. Section Street, Fairhope, AL.

Age of Campers: PreK3 (**fully** potty trained) through children entering 3rd grade in Fall of 2023.

Camp Dates: June 12th - July 21st (The week of July 4th will be a shortened 3-day week).

All camp tuition(s) are due by May 31st. No refunds will be given for days that are paid and not attended.

Parents/guardians must sign campers in and out each day.

Meals and Snacks

All campers will be responsible for their own water bottle, a nut–free morning and afternoon snack and a lunch. A catered school lunch will be offered on M, W, & F for an extra cost. All lunches are pre-ordered because our venues require us to order a week in advance.

Children who rest may bring a plush toy from home for rest time only. We recommend that favorite toys be left at home, as we cannot guarantee that items will not be lost.
